## **Official TCC Collaborative Members / Partners**

- 1. The team identified two steps in designating organizations as official TCC partners:
  - a. Making and signing a commitment to be trauma informed via a covenant or pledge.
  - b. Identifying steps they were taking & where they are in the process of becoming trauma informed.

There were some issues raised around these 2 topics, of particular note:

- There was a desire to measure how organizations were progressing in becoming trauma informed, and so the measurement would need to be taken annually in order to track progress
- There were concerns around the language "memorandum of understanding" and the legalities associated with it particuarly with unbrella organizations that may be composed of more than one group that they might not necessarily control. As a result we are moving forward with a 'Covenant'. This language generated less opposition.
- 2. A preliminary version of both of these tools have been developed for review by the TCC steering committee. These are based on the ACES Connection asset mapping tool, the TCC current mission and goals, the as well as the MOU used by Tarpon Springs, FL:

# **Engagement Tools & Expanding the Collaborative to Include Other Sectors**

Separately, outside of the meeting an idea to have a Trauma informed "Film Festival" was suggested (similar to one that's being held in Philly).
